Over the past three decades, Community Transit has grown from a small, local bus service into a leader in local and regional transportation. Community Transit began service Oct. 4, 1976 with 18 buses and 7 routes. Today, Community Transit operates 33 local and 31 commuter bus routes and now serves more than 2,100 stops. In 2007, Community Transit became one of the nation's first transit agencies to put a double decker bus into regular commuter service and by 2009, will become the first agency in the region to have a rapid transit system. Community Transit services the Greater Seattle Metropolitan Area.
