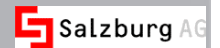

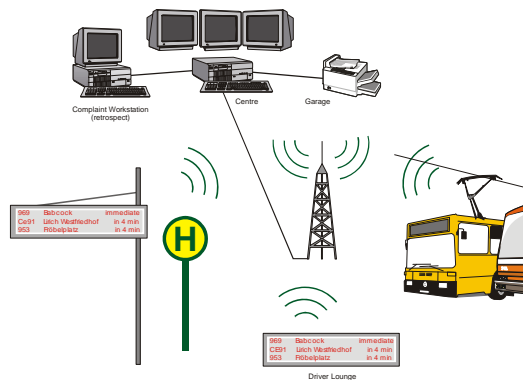
- Intermodal Transport Control System – ITCS (former CAD/AVL)

Salzburg (population 150,000 in 2006) is a city in Western Austria and the capital of the federal state of Salzburg. The city is noted for its baroque architecture and Alpine setting. It was the birthplace of Mozart and the setting for the musical and film *The Sound of Music*. The composer Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart was also raised in Salzburg, for whose archbishops he worked from 1769 to 1781. His house of birth and residence are popular tourist attractions. His family is buried in a small church graveyard in the old town, and there are many monuments to "Wolferl" in the city.
